We have come to the end of a very busy three months and are excited to share with you what the Lord has done and is doing. Thank you so much to all of you who have given of your time to pray for our family. It means so much when someone tells us, "I will be praying for you."

We have been to twelve churches in the last three months and the Lord has given us wonderful meetings. New Hampshire, Alabama, Missouri, Indiana, North Carolina, Virginia, Maryland, Delaware and Illinois are the states we've been in. We've been blessed to be part of Awana programs, a homeschool group presentation, several Alaska presentations geared for children, and three missions conferences.

We know many of you have been praying that our deputation ministry would be blessed. During these meeting the last few months, people have given their lives to ministry, and at least two individuals have accepted Christ as their Savior. Praise Him! One of the biggest blessing was receiving two youth violins from a church. We are planning on Rachel using these in Iliamna and other villages in AK to teach music to native kids and our own kids.

When we sent our last letter we reported that our support was at 51% and asked prayer for that to grow. God has raised that to now 67%. We are so encouraged. It is a special moment in our family when we announce to our kids that a certain church emailed and said they voted to take us on for support. Anna and James immediately go through their memory banks from that church and get excited that they will see their friends there again. It is a unique joy in our family.

With the faith-filled expectation of moving to Alaska the end of next summer we are making preparations. We are planning to purchase an enclosed trailer from another missionary family that will transport our belongings. We are also beginning to actively raise money for purchasing property in Iliamna where we can build a house. We ask you to pray the Lord would give us His mind as we begin to plan interim housing arrangements in Iliamna. Again, we only have a short window of time when the building materials can be barged to the village, and shortly after that window of time ends, so does the building season.
